


## Current LNC Regions

## Forming LNC Regions

Use the *Members* column of the table to form representative regions for the Libertarian National Committee. One LNC representative is authorized for each 10% of party membership: 1413 members for a Single Region (10% of 14125) and 2825 members for a Double Region (20% of 14125). **The region formation period opens February 23 and closes on May 24.** State chairs should report newly formed regions to the National Secretary (Bob Sullentrup) using the Region Formation form on page 30 of the Delegation Chairs Manual. **It's never too early to start informally forming regions.** I highly recommend forming regions at LSLA. Don't put it off until the last minute.
